**Applications will be evaluated based on:** 

Completion of a 500-750 word essay that addresses: **MUST BE TYPED**

- 2) How do I promote the sport of bowling? Evidence of outstanding character, integrity, leadership, and self-motivation:
  - 1) What school activities do you participate in?
  - 2) What community service activities have you been involved in?
    - a. Please describe how the activity impacted the community.

Though not required, letters of reference (no more than 2) from your coach or other non-family member are encouraged. The reference should address topics such as conduct, knowledge of bowling, sportsmanship, behavior, and promotion of bowling.
